

Ch 13: Assessing Psychological Tests

Find a psychological test online that tests either personality, IQ, achievement or interests (but NOT mental illness).

Ideally, you would be able to find a test **influenced** by one of the following:

- The Stanford-Binet Intelligence Test
- The Wechsler Adult Intelligence test
- General Aptitude Test Battery (GATB)
- Differential Aptitude Test (DATE)
- Campbell Interest and Skill Survey
- Kurder Preference Record
- The MMPI
- CPI
- Myers-Briggs Test
- Rorschach Inkblot test
- TAT

Please do not simply settle on the first Buzzfeed Quiz you find. Do some searching, try and find one that is **academic**.

After you've selected your test:

1. Take the test, record your results. **RETAKE** the test and record your new results.
2. On the Unit 3 page of your ePortfolio, create a heading called "Psychological Testing"
3. Under the heading, introduce the test you wrote (Title, and link) and comment on the following:
 - a. What type of test was it?
 - b. Who created it?
 - c. How/for whom would the test be useful?
 - d. Was your test credible? (*Was the site you took your test from covered in ads? Why might that be a consideration?*)
 - e. Is your test reliable? Why or why not?
 - f. Is your test valid? How do you know?

Please use full sentences and thoughtful responses. I will be looking at how thorough your comments are and if you've included all of the above.
