- You should have 5 main pages (1 for each of the units): Intro, Unit 1, Unit 2, Unit 3, Blog.
- Ensure that your reflections are all found on your "Reflections" Blog page.
- Make sure the "Unit 3 Subpage" for your energy Project is actually under your Unit 3 page
- You might consider including a Science- themed Home page.
- Use spacers & dividers to organize your eP. It should be clean and uncluttered and really easy to navigate.

In our interview, I will ask you the following questions. Your task is to prepare your responses ahead of time. You may refer to your eP during our conversation.

- 1) Tell me about 2 things that you learned about in each unit.
 - How can it apply to your life (or life in general?)
 - What is another question that you have that would further your learning?
- 2) Walk me through your eP.
 - What would you do differently?
 - How would you improve it?
 - What do you like best about it?

3) What grade/comment do you believe you deserve to see in your report card for this course?

- Why? Provide evidence.
- Better, less than or the same as your midterm? (see me for this)

4) Think about this course as a whole:

- What did you like about it?
- What do you think could be improved?



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
